




Academic excellence - Reading


In 2022 we continued an upward trend across all levels

Year 1-10 = 89% of all students were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Reading. Year 9 – 10 = 90%



2020 - 86% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 88%

2019 - 85% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 65%



Academic excellence - Writing

In 2022 we saw overall results improving year to year

Year 1-10 - 88% of all students were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Writing. **Year 9 - 10 = 92%**



2020 - 81% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 79%


2019 - 76% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 71%



Academic excellence - Mathematics


In 2022 strong achievement in Mathematics continued

Year 1-10 = 91% of all students were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Mathematics. Year 9 and 10 = 98%



2020 - 88% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 89%


2019 - 85% of all students (Year 1-10) were "At or Above" expectations for OTJ Year 9 - 10 = 76%
